Introduce concept of long range planning and goal setting.

Develop skills to locate and use career information.

Understand how interest, abilities and achievements relate to achieving personal, social, educational and career goals.

Exploration Grade 9, 10, & 11

- Acquire skills such as team work, problem solving, and organization.
- Reexamine personal skills, interest and abilities in relation to current career choices.
- Identify personal preferences and interest that influence career choices and success.
- Review graduation status annually. Review course selections and make any necessary modifications.
- Introduction to Personal Career Portfolio Development. Collect samples of your best work; awards, certificates, achievements.
- Refine career searches to reflect personal skills and interest.
- Pursue and develop competency in areas of interest.
- Visit post-secondary institutions to explore programs.
- Apply academic and career readiness skills in work-based learning situations such as job shadowing and Saskatchewan Youth Apprenticeship projects.
- Update Personal Career Portfolio annually.
