- · This mellow, sweet apple is delicious eaten fresh
- Very juicy and good for apple juice or cider
- Popular for pies, sauces and apple butter

BC Ambrosia Apples:

- · Pink-tinged orange/red flush over a yellow background
- Best described as refreshing, pleasant crisp,
- · Very sweet with little acid
- Naturally doesn't turn brown quickly after being sliced
- · Perfect for snacks or salads

BC Royal Gala Apples: \$4(

- A crisp, firm, bright red or red/orange patterned fruit with a yellow background
- · Cross between a golden delicious and Kidd's orange Red apple
- · Sweet and juicy, good for eating, on salads
