1. Call to order at 7:40 Karen, Nadine, Danielle, Tracy, Mark, Venessa, Naomi and Stephanie
2. Approval and Additions of last meeting minutes- Meeting minutes approved by Nadine and seconded by Venessa, all were in favor.
3. Financial Report from Venessa

4. Old Business

The budget came out in March and has not increased for our division. With a declining enrollment and the costs going up there will most likely be a 0.5 cut coming to our school.
