

Second Step Parent Information

This month, our schoolwide theme is friendship skills. In our morning announcements we'll be reminding students to use the *Second Step* **Friendship Skills** such as:

- Inviting others to play
- Playing fairly
- Making amends
- Handling name-calling

Second Step lessons specifically teach students to use each step and reinforce the message to use fairways to play and help make better choices when sharing, trading, or taking turns. Helping students to identify ways to play fairly through sharing, trading, and taking turns. Students will continue to learn friendship skills to handle interpersonal conflicts effectively. When we reinforce successful use of friendship skills, students will use the skills more outside of *Second Step l*esson time.



Grade 4 OurSCHOOL Survey Results

In April our Grade 4 students completed the second snapshot of OurSCHOOL Survey. Below are a few of the outcomes along with a couple of comments stating how the students rated our school:

- In our school 84% of students have a high sense of belonging; the Canadian norm is 83%.
- In our school 91% of students are interested and motivated in their learning; the Canadian norm is 88%.
