SCHOOL BUS SAFETY AND THE STOP ARM

The single biggest threat to the safety of children who ride school buses is motorists who pass the bus when the children are loading or unloading.

- ▼ Motorists traveling in BOTH directions must stop when approaching a stopped school bus with its stop arm out and flashing lights activated.
- Motorists are required to stop no closer than five meters from the front or the back of the bus until the indicators are deactivated.
- ▼ In addition to the threat of immediate danger to a child, drivers who refuse to stop can be fined.

Always exercise caution when approaching a school bus.
