"Helping Hands" will be sold for \$1 each.

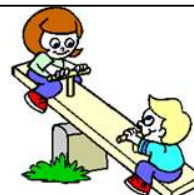

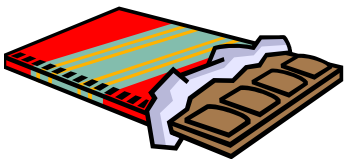

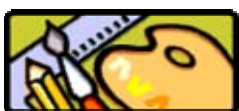
