### Educational Goals for Lakeview Elementary School:

### Resource:

- Programs are developed to assist the child and allow him/her to progress in the classroom. Parents are required to sign a consent form. The emphasis is on the least restrictive environment/inclusion

### Library:

- **Open for independent use by students 8:35 – 8:55 a.m. and 3:30 – 4:00 p.m.**
- **Internet Access** – Elementary School offers Internet access for student use. Our Acceptable Use Policy governs student use of our computer system. **Parental consent is assumed for students to publish material/photos on the Web. Contact the school if you do not want your child's material/photos published.** Failure to comply with the regulations will result in the loss of privileges. If you wish to see the complete Acceptable Use Policy, please call the school.

### Child Abuse and Neglect:

- A staff member of the NWSD has a duty to report suspicions of Child Abuse or Neglect. This means that it is not their job to investigate possible cases of neglect or abuse, but to report suspicions.
- NWSD supports the use of Personal Care Programs such as "CARE" (K) and "Feeling Yes, Feeling No" (Gr. 4). Parental Consent is required.
