Illness at School:

- Please provide an alternative number in the event that a parent is unavailable

Accidents at School:

- We attempt to contact parents
- If parents are not available and the accident appears serious, the child will be taken to the hospital/clinic for treatment
- Parents will be notified as soon as possible
- School staff will **not** sign for treatment by a doctor

Communicable Diseases:

- According to the *Education Act*, a teacher may exclude a student from the classroom if the student is suffering or recovering from or has been in contact with a communicable disease

Health:

- Parents must notify the school, teacher and bus driver if their child has any health problems requiring special care
- Medication will be administered **ONLY AFTER** a medical release form has been signed

Lice Policy:

- Lakeview conducts regular lice checks in classrooms.
- If your child has live lice they will be discretely taken to the community room and a phone call will go home informing the parents. Students will not be allowed back to school until they have been treated and nits picked.

Fire Drills or Emergency Evacuation:

- Drills are held to teach evacuation procedures
- Students without inside shoes, are required to go out in sock feet

Dress Code:

- Students' appearance should be neat, clean and safe.
- Fashions with suggestive graphics or language which reflects anti-social, racism, or which promote alcohol, tobacco, or other drug use will not be tolerated.
- Parents will be contacted if their child disregards this dress code
- We remove our hats and footwear upon entering the building
