

SCHOOL HOURS

Background

The length of the instructional year will be a minimum of 950 hours and shall be in accordance with legislation and pursuant to the procedures established by the Director.

Procedures

- 1. The instructional day shall be three hundred and ten (310) minutes excluding recess periods which total not less than thirty (30) minutes for elementary schools.
- 2. The Director or designate, after consulting with the Principal, shall determine the time at which classes ordinarily start, and dismissal of students ordinarily occur in a school. When arriving at these decisions, parental, School Community Council and transportation concerns are to be considered.
- 3. Kindergarten students are to attend a minimum of four hundred and seventy-five (475) hours of instruction time.
- 4. Principals, in consultation with the Director, may dismiss school at any time before the usual dismissal time where the health, safety or welfare of students or staff is threatened.
