

GUIDANCE AND CAREER COUNSELING PROGRAM

Background

The Division directs that guidance and career counseling services be provided to students to enable them to plan, select and pursue studies for their educational, personal and vocational advancement.

Procedures

1. All principals are required to adopt and implement career education programming in grades 6 to 9 following the provincial Career Education curriculum guidelines.
2. Secondary schools are required to implement career counseling services for students, providing them with specific information regarding career clinics, tests related to career choices and information pertaining to post-secondary institutions.
3. Direction regarding the provision of personal counseling services is contained within the Student Services Handbook.
