Before we move forward, you must know that our mobile photo studios are following the strictest rules outlined by the Saskatchewan Health Authority- including cleaning methods, wearing masks, and social distancing. Please arrive no earlier than 5 minutes prior to your appointment time. Late arrivals may have to be rescheduled in our studio. On completion of your sitting, please leave the room. Only graduates will be allowed in the room (special circumstances allowed) at their appointment time > **No friend/sibling/pet photos.**

If you are experiencing any symptoms related to Covid-19 as outlined by Saskatchewan Health Services, please do not come to your appointment, we will be happy to reschedule you on a later date. Only the graduate will be allowed into our location. We will only be accepting debit, credit or exact cash for sitting fees. No change will be available.

The Full Grad Session includes: \$30.00

Each graduate is photographed in a gown in your school's colors. Graduates are encouraged to wear a white shirt and tie, or v-neck shirt under the gown. **(The shirt and tie will NOT be supplied)** Each graduate will have a twenty minute sitting for these photographs which includes 18-20 different poses.

Graduates are encouraged to bring a prop for their photo session (musical instrument, basketball, football jersey etc.)

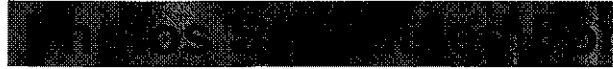
***Yearbook Only Sessions*:** (No charge for this service)

Photos - Life Touch will be taking grad photos on **February 22-24, 2021**

PLEASE NOTE: You **must** have your picture taken, but you **do not** have to pay the sitting fee if you **do not** plan on purchasing photos from Life Touch. Photos of all grads are needed for the yearbook, the school composite, evening PowerPoint and the newspaper.

A sitting fee is to be paid to the photographer the day of photos if students want to purchase the photo proofs. Life Touch will provide us with information with regards to their on line booking of picture sessions (Sitting fee is \$30.00).

Participation in Graduation Exercises – This is not mandatory.

It is school policy that only students who have **completed** Grade XII or who are **enrolled in courses** that, when complete, would make them **eligible** for a Grade XII standing will be **allowed to participate** in the school's graduation exercises.

Students in their **final term** of attendance in Grade XII must **maintain an average** of at least **40%** in classes required for graduation in order to participate in the exercises. The school reserves the right to **refuse participation** of any student for reasons of poor attendance or inappropriate misbehavior.

To be eligible to participate in the graduation ceremonies students **must** meet the following criteria:

A. You Must Pass:

- English Language Art A (30 or 31)
- English Language Arts B (30 or 31)
- History 30, or Native Studies 30
- Two other 30 level classes

B. You must have a total of twenty four credits which must include the following criteria:

- At least 5 credits at Grade 12 level. - see above
- All compulsory subjects (Grade 10 and 11 - ELA 10/20A, Math 10, Science 10, Native Studies or History 10)
- At least one credit in Physical Education or Wellness (10, 20 or 30 level)
- At least two credits in the Practical and Applied Arts or Fine Arts (grade 10, 11 or

12)

A Math at the 20 or 30 level.

A Science at the 20 or 30 level.

A Social science

Adult 12

English Language Arts A (30 or 31)

English Language Arts B (30 or 31)

History 30/31, or Native Studies 30/31

Math 20/21

Science 20 or 21

Two other 30 level classes

In June, students with less than 40% in a compulsory class will be contacted about participation in graduation. Laggard students must raise averages in all subjects in order to be eligible for graduation participation. Please understand that students with two or more failing grades will be contacted as well.

Students must also have all school fees paid to the office or online through SchoolCash in order to participate in the ceremonies.

Scholarships and Bursaries – Students must apply for local Scholarships. These are decided based on average, participation in school and community, and other factors. Forms are available at the office, or from Mrs Waterman.

Grad Tickets

The number of Grad tickets available is not yet determined. We will make that information available as the date approaches. In the past, packages of 8 tickets were sold for approximately \$30. This will continue in a similar manner if possible

School Activity Policy

Graduation is a school activity therefore the following rules apply:

1. You **must** have paid all outstanding **School Fees**. Please see Mrs Lepage at the office for an updated list of school fees you are owing if you are unsure.
2. Use of **alcohol / tobacco / vaping and drugs are strictly prohibited.**

Cap and Gown rental for afternoon grad activities

The \$30.00 rental fee covers the following:

- stole and gown rental
- memento cap and tassel purchase

Rehearsal (Date to be Determined)

All grads must attend!!! Bring the shoes that you will be wearing

- *Processional into the afternoon program
- *Recessional out from the afternoon program
- *Valedictorian will practice his/her speech
- *Thank you's will be practiced

Tuesday June 29th - Graduation Day

- *Grads need to arrive no later than 11:00 am to pick up Grad Gown
- *Please remember to eat something before coming but we will have snacks
- *Water bottles - you cannot bring your own water, but there will be bottled water provided for you
- *Attire for exercises
 - Males:** White shirt with collar, black pants, black socks and dress shoes
 - Females:** white shirt with collar and dress shoes. In the past, female Grads have worn short shorts under their gowns.)
- *Grad Gowns are to be returned after the exercises. The gowns must be hung back on a hanger. Gowns that are not hung up will result in a charge of \$25.00. (Your gown and hanger are marked with your name.) Grad Gowns that are not returned will cost the grad \$75.00.
