Principal's Message

We had both mild and cold days of weather during the month of January. On some of the days there were buses that did not run. On several occasions, the temperature (including windchill) dipped to a balmy, tropical -40 degrees Celsius or colder. We had several calls from parents asking if the school was closed that day. We never close the school for cold weather and the teachers will be here just in case some students brave the elements and decide to walk to school.

It is important to phone and let us know if you are keeping your child at home, unless he or she is a rural bus student. If the rural buses don't run then we won't be looking for the children of the cancelled bus routes. If a non-bus or city bus student does not show up we will phone you to see if you have sent them off to school. It is important to get notification from parents as soon as possible just in case a student has gone missing on the way to school in the frigid weather conditions.

In regards to busing, the individual bus drivers will decide if their bus will run and they will phone all of the parents on their route to inform them that their route is cancelled for that day. Students, if your bus brings you to school then the bus will pick you up. If your bus doesn't come but you get to school anyway, the bus will not be picking you up after school, even if the weather warms up. Parents, if your child does get to school on these days they will benefit greatly from a low pupil/teacher ratio.

Our Family Dance will take place on Thursday, February 7th. The SCC will be selling popcorn, candy apples and water at the concession. They will also be running rocks and rings and lollipop pull contests for two awesome mystery prizes. Students can purchase bucket buster tickets for \$3. All proceeds will go towards SCC family engagement events, staff and parent volunteer appreciation. We are looking forward to seeing everyone at this year's Family Dance!




