
If your child(ren) are new or have not used this system you will need your childs student number. Please contact the school for this.

ECheck is a method of payment that allows you to make a one-time direct debit electronic funds transfer from your chequing or savings account.

To make a payment by eCheck in Canada you will need:

- your bank's institution number
- your branch's transit number
- your account number

For safety and efficiency reasons, NWSD would like to reduce the amount of cash & checks coming into our school. Please join the thousands of parents who have already registered and are enjoying the convenience of paying ONLINE! It takes less than 5 minutes to register. Please follow these step-by-step instructions, so you will begin to receive email notifications regarding upcoming events involving your child(ren).

NOTE: If you require assistance, select the SUPPORT option in the top right hand corner of the screen.

Step 1: Register

- a) If you have not registered, please go to the School Cash Online home page https://nwsd.schoolcashonline.com/
 and select the "Register" option.
- b) Complete each of the three Registration Steps
 *For Security Reasons your password, requires 8 characters,
 one uppercase letter, one lowercase letter and a number.



Step 2: Confirmation Email


A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account. The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find Student

This step will connect your children to your account.

- a) Enter the School Board Name.
- b) Enter the School Name.
- Enter Your Child's Student Number and Last Name.
- d) Select Continue.
- e) On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select Continue.
- f) Your child has been added to your account.





Step 4: View Items or Add Another Student

If you have more children, select "Add Another Student" and repeat the steps above. 8 children can be added to one parent account. If you do not wish to add additional children, select "View Items For Students" option. A listing of available items for purchase will be displayed.

BC Mac Apples:

- · This fruit has red and green skin
- Tart flavour
- Tender white flesh is crisp when freshly harvested but soon adopts a softer consistency, perfect for cooking into pies or sauce.
- · Good for raw eating

BC Ambrosia Apples:

\$50/Box

- Pink-tinged orange/red flush over a yellow background
- Best described as refreshing, pleasant crisp,
- Very sweet with little acid
- Naturally doesn't turn brown quickly after being sliced
- Perfect for snacks or salads





\$45/Box

- Very much a "Macintosh" style apple, bright crimson skin and white flesh
- · Straight from the tree the flesh is very crisp and juicy
- · Good for juicing, sweet and pleasant
- · Good eating apple and baking

\$45/Box

BC Royal Gala Apples:

- A crisp, firm, bright red or red/orange patterned fruit with a yellow background
- Cross between a golden delicious and Kidd's orange Red apple
- · Sweet and juicy, good for eating, on salads
