

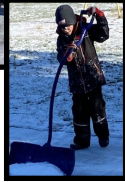
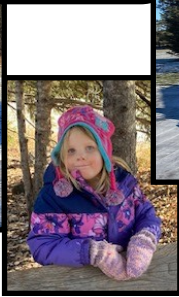

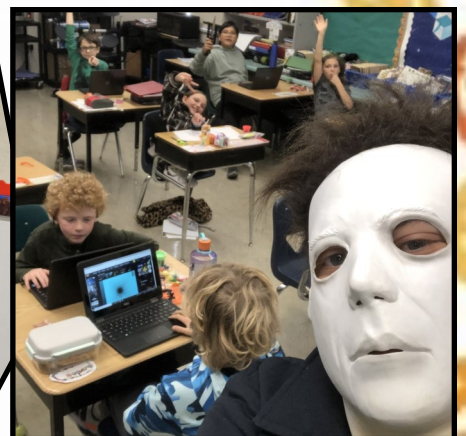

Wellness Corner with Mrs. Klassen



Do you ever find your children's stories about their days at school a bit....confusing? It can be hard to follow without the backstory of their full day, and all that happens in it! Sometimes the old stand by "how was your day" becomes so mundane that it fails to evoke any interest in sharing. Here are a few conversation starters that might help promote a deeper conversation.

- * **DID ANYTHING SILLY HAPPEN TODAY?**
- * **WHAT WAS YOUR FAVORITE PART OF YOUR LUNCH?**
- * **WHAT GAMES DID YOU PLAY AT RECESS?**
- * **WAS THERE ANYTHING THAT SURPRISED YOU TODAY?**
- * **WHAT MADE YOUR TEACHER THE MOST PROUD TODAY?**
- * **WHAT MADE YOU THINK EXTRA HARD TODAY?**
- * **WHAT WAS THE FUNNIEST THING YOU HEARD TODAY?**
- * **WHAT DID YOU DO TODAY THAT WAS KIND?**

One of the most important qualities that goes along with asking questions is waiting for the answer, and then building on the answer.

Another fun way to go deeper is to ask your child, "What would you like to know about my day today?" They enjoy being in control of the conversation and the results are two-fold as you model reciprocity and how to think of others. Every now and again the extra effort will pay off!
