Reminders to Parents Dropping off and Picking up Students



- **1** School Doors open at 8:35am. Please do not send your children to school before 8:35am as there are no teachers on supervision and children will have to wait outside.
- **2** Do not drop off your children on the East side of Railway Avenue. Elementary kids are small and even though they are supposed to look both ways and watch for cars, we all know they do not always remember to do so. Please drop off / pick up your children where they do not have to cross the road using the West Railway Avenue side of the road only. If you are running late when dropping off your child, please drop them off at the Main Office Doors as they need to check-in at the office.
- **3** Remember bus safety! Do not ever pass a stopped school bus. Our bus drop off / pick up is 1st Street, so between the times of 8:30 to 8:45 and 3:00 to 3:20 the street is closed to public traffic.

Edsby


On September 12th, parents/guardians of registered students will receive an email inviting them to join the Edsby platform. There will be an app for parents to download to help ease use.
