## STUDENT DROP OFF/PICK UP

Families bringing their children to school by vehicle are asked to drop off at the sidewalk so that children are not crossing the street to get to the school. Think safety! Do not drop off your children from the west side of the street.



Please do not park or idle in the BLUE Handicap Zone. There is a drop off and pick up here each morning and after school.

The parking lot and bus lane are for staff/school division vehicles only. These lanes are closed to all other traffic to keep our students safe. Please remind family and friends who drop off and pick up your children.



## SCHOOL SUPPLIES / FEES

We ask that families provide good quality athletic shoes with non-marking soles, a good quality backpack, lunch kit and water bottle.

A School Supplies/Activities Fee of \$75 per student covers all other school supplies and extra-curricular, special guest and/or event costs, and various other school related activities.
