3. OURSchool Survey Results (all grade 4-6 students take the survey – anonymously)

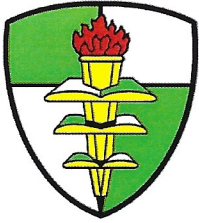
- a. Food Options – Boston Pizza (pasta), Taco in a Bag, Burgers (school does), Arby's McDonald's
