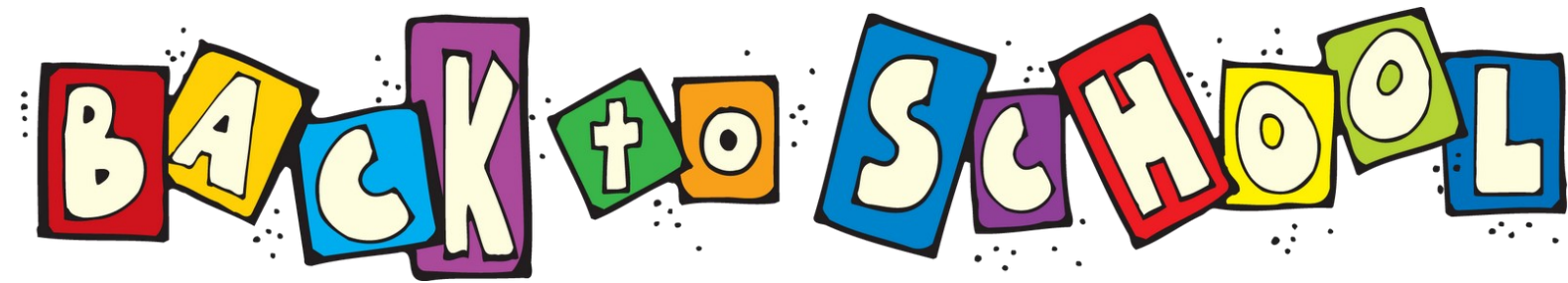

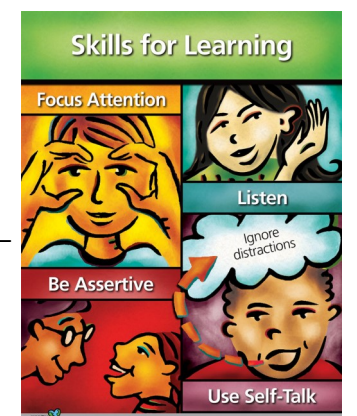
The goal of Following Their Voices is to provide education that is relational and culturally responsive to accelerate the progress and achievement of First Nations, Metis, and Inuit students.

Social Emotional Learning

School isn't just a place to grow academically; it's a place to grow as a person. When children feel safe, supported, and connected to their school, they're better equipped to succeed academically and in life.

Children need social-emotional skills to thrive both in the classroom and in life. Social-emotional learning teaches children techniques to: gain confidence, set goals, make better decisions, collaborate with others in work and play and navigate the world more effectively.

Second Step is implemented in all K-Gr. 4 classrooms. Second Step® Elementary is designed to help kids succeed in school and in life by teaching them skills for learning—such as focusing attention and listening—as well as how to manage their emotions, solve problems, and make friends. These skills can help them in the classroom, on the job, or wherever life takes them.

Lakeview School Handbook/Student Agenda

Our handbook appears at the front of each student agenda. Every student in kindergarten to Grade 4 has an agenda. We ask parents to check and sign the agenda nightly. Parents and students should take some time to review the calendar so that you are aware of all that Lakeview has to offer. If your child should lose their agenda book there is a **\$10.00** charge for a new one.

Parking

No-parking zones are clearly marked on all roads around the school. Please do not park in areas that are marked with yellow paint or in the staff parking lot across from the bus lane, as we do not want students/parents walking where the buses drive. There is no parking across from the front entrance between **8:30 a.m.** and **5:00 p.m.** Please! Please! Please! Do not put your children at risk by having them walk across the street to where you are illegally parked. Inform your children to meet you on one of the side streets by the school.

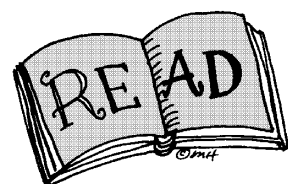
Our first meeting will be held on **September 13th, at 7:00 p.m. at Lakeview. All parents are welcome!!**

School Cash

School Cash is an online parent portal that offers a safe, fast and convenient way to pay for school activity fees. The portal is customized to meet your school's needs and allows parents to add students, make payments, check current balance/account history and print or view receipts.

School Cash registration sheet will go home within the next month. Your child's unique student number will be located on this sheet.

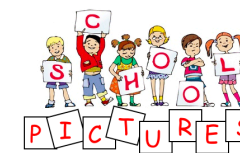


Spirit Days
