Principal and Vice-Principal's Message

In December our Grade 4 Students completed the OurSCHOOL Survey. Below are a few of the outcomes along with a couple comments stating how the students rated our school:

- 84% of our students have a high sense of belonging; the Canadian norm for this grade is 83%.
- In our school, 84% of students have positive relationships; the Canadian norm for this grade is 84%.
- 96% of our students value school outcomes; the Canadian norm for this grade is 96%.
- 98% of our students are interested and motivated; the Canadian norm for this grade is 88%.
- In our school, students rated our classroom instruction as well organized, with a clear purpose, and with the immediate and appropriate feedback that helps them learn as 8.6 out of 10; the Canadian norm for this grade is 8.5.
- In our school, positive teacher-student relations were rated 8.8 out of 10; the Canadian Norm for these grades is 8.6.
- Students rated classroom instruction relevant to their everyday lives as 8.6 out of 10; the Canadian norm for this grade is 8.2.

NWSD is accepting English and French Immersion kindergarten registrations for the 2021-2022 school year. Children must be 5 years old on or before December 31, 2021. Registration forms may be completed at any Northwest School Division school or at the School Division office located at 525 5th Street West. Forms should be completed by **March 31st, 2021**. Verification of age will be required. (Birth certificate and/or Saskatchewan Health card)



SECOND STEP

This month, our school-wide theme is **emotion management**. In our morning announcements, we'll be prompting students to notice their own feelings by paying attention to clues in their bodies, and we'll be reminding them to use their *Second Step* skills to calm down:

Stop—Use your signal

Name your feeling

Calm down: Breathe, count, use positive self-talk

These skills help students calm down strong emotions when faced with learning and social challenges, which helps them succeed academically and get along well with others.

Second Step lessons specifically teach about calming down strong emotions such as anger, disappointment, frustration, and anxiety.
