1. Welcome

Meeting started at 19:02

2. Adoption of agenda

Kelly made a motion to adopt minutes, Nadisha seconds motion. All in favour. Agenda adopted.

3. Report from school/wellness coordinator

Santa Store- overwhelming support from the community. There are some volunteers from the church to help run the store. A wrapping station will be set up in Mrs Oystrick's classroom and a schedule has been made for classes to access store one class at a time. If parents are wanting to volunteer to let staff know.

Lots of viruses going around school, there has been a lot of absenteeism.

4. New business

- **Christmas raffle. Handing raffle tickets out to the students Dec 4 and to be back by Dec 15th & draw to be made December 20th. Donations from Home Hardware and The Source. Amanda & Kellie decided we didn't need to pick up the movie theatre tickets**
6000 tickets printed and have been stapled into booklets for distribution and sale. Amanda thinks there could be a demand for more. Jocelyn suggests that we look to expand lottery licence so that if we need to sell more we can. Decision to have movie passes as incentive for the child who sells the most tickets.
- **Volunteers for Santa Store Dec 11th-15th**
Volunteers can come between 9am-3pm on any day. Phone the school office and let them know if you can make it.
- **Friendship Feast Dec 20th**
Service will begin at 11:30. Co-op donated all the turkeys. Kids are asked to bring their own utensils, plates, and cup in a ziplock bag. Jocelyn and Kellie suggested that the school have extra cutlery on hand in case some children forget.
- **Christmas family night**
Frosty Melodies will be at 13:00 on the 13th of December (Wednesday) and it will be recorded and posted on Edsby.
December 18th will be craft family night. Each grade will make a different craft. Hot chocolate will be served. The night was sponsored by Innovation Credit Union. Parents voted against having a Santa there for the night.

➤ **Make a final decision about the outdoor classroom**

Ongoing concern about vandalization of property expressed by Amanda Pockrant. Prince Albert's outdoor classroom is fenced and this may be something to consider.

Jocelyn raised concern that this has been a constant fixture in meetings without any resolution. A vote was held whether the SCC should continue with planning for an outdoor classroom- 4 in favour and 4 against.

A smaller group of SCC members interested in getting this going should meet to discuss plans. If they manage to come up with a plan that the school staff approve of they can present it at an SCC meeting for approval for potential funding. This topic should fall off the regular SCC agenda until there is a definite plan.
