FIRE PREVENTION WEEK (Oct. 6-12)

Not every hero wears a cape

“Plan and Practice your Escape!”

Reminds us that we need to take personal steps to increase our safety from fire and how to escape safely in the event of one:

- Look for places fire could start. Take a good look around your home. Identify potential fire hazards and take care of them.
- Listen for the sound of the smoke alarm. You could have only minutes to escape safely once the smoke alarm sounds. Go to your outside meeting place, which should be a safe distance from the home and where everyone should meet.
- Learn two ways out of every room and make sure all doors and windows leading outside open easily and are free of clutter.

SCHOOL LOCKDOWN PROCEDURE

Training and practice drills are essential to the successful implementation of our Emergency Response Plan. Our school is required to complete a minimum of 3 lockdown drills during the school year. On October 8, we will be practicing a school lockdown in the morning. During the lockdown students will be in a locked classroom hiding out of sight from a potential threat that may be in our school. We are hoping the Marsden Fire department will be able to attend. In doing this, it is our hope that students will become familiar with the procedures of a lockdown and recognize that in the case of an actual event, they will hear sirens, people entering our school, and the notification of when it is safe to evacuate. SCHOOL BUS SAFETY AND THE STOP ARM

The single biggest threat to the safety of children who ride school buses is motorists who pass the bus when the children are loading or unloading.

- ♥ Motorists traveling in **BOTH** directions must stop when approaching a stopped school bus with its stop arm out and flashing lights activated.
- ♥ Motorists are required to stop no closer than five meters from the front or the back of the bus until the indicators are deactivated.
- ♥ In addition to the threat of immediate danger to a child, drivers who refuse to stop can be fined.

Always exercise caution when approaching a school bus.
They transport precious cargo!

PLEASE REMEMBER WHEN THE BUSES ARE IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL LOADING & UNLOADING THERE IS TO BE NO VEHICLES PARKING ACROSS FROM OR DRIVING PAST THE BUSES. THIS IS FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY!
