  - School is not closing this June.
  - Duane will talk to the NWSD board in September about putting Marsden School into review.
  - If the decision is to go into review Duane & Aaron will post signs in the community.
  - Committees will be formed to present ideas of how to keep the school open or the SCC can write a letter earlier in the year to say they agree & support the school closing at the end of the 2023 school year. This will help to make transitions for students and decisions as to where all the stuff in our school will go.
  - In April or May, the NWSD board will make the final decision if the school will remain open or close at the end of the 2023 school year. In order to make the final decision the board will look at everything presented by the community, SCC and the Director.
