- ✚ **Fruit Trees:** Joyce shared a program that is being run by Sask Water Shed, that donates fruit trees and shrubs to school for the kids to plant. We have sent in our request for trees. This will include hot dogs, buns, condiments, hot chocolate, apple cider, water, chips (small bags). Joyce will ask for a donation for pumpkins, and if we are not able to have them donated, we will purchase them. Martina will purchase and be reimbursed for any face painting supplies that she may need.
- ✚ **Poly Spots: *Motion Made by Kim, seconded by Bonnie & Carried*** We will pay up to \$100 for Poly Spots to use in the Gym.
- ✚ **Breakfast Program:** We discussed the revamping of the breakfast program. With it being more widely open to any and all students, with the possibility of doing a hot breakfast once in a while, we will reach out for donations from the community to those who have previously asked if we needed anything for this specific program.
