# 1. J.S. Palmer Family Scholarship (SD Held)

June 1

\$300. The Palmer family scholarship is an award giving to a Neilburg Composite School grade 12 that will be attending a recognized post-secondary school. The course must be one year in length or more. This is primarily based on financial need. Applicants must write a letter including plans for schooling, financial need and a little background about themselves. Submit application to the Principal of Neilburg Composite School (cc to the Guidance Counsellor). This award will be announced at NCS award day. Deadline is June 1. The recipient will be required to submit proof of registration.

## 2. Kathleen Ostrom Award (SD Held)

June 1

\$300. The Ostrom Family created this award to honour Kathleen Ostrom who loved music and her church. The criterion is a grade 12 girl attending post secondary student that is involved in music and/or her church. A letter must be submitted by email to the Principal of Neilburg Composite School (cc to the Guidance Counsellor) explaining the post secondary program, church involvement and musically involvement. This award will be given out at NCS awards day. The recipient will be required to submit proof of registration.

## 3. NCS Award Sponsored by Classes of 2014 & 2018 (locally held) June

\$250. An award available to all grade 12's playing on attending a post-secondary course that is 6 months or longer. Applicants must apply with a paragraph explain the post secondary plans. Submit application to the Guidance Counsellor of Neilburg Composite School. This is a lotto draw award & will be given out at NCS awards day. The recipient will be required to submit proof of registration.

## 4. Resilience Award (Joline Houk)

May 10

This is a local award given to a student in Grade 12 from Neilburg Composite School. A three paragraph essay on resilience in your life is required. There is also an application form that is required. This is awarded at June awards day.

#### 5. Artland Ladies Bursary

June 1

Award giving to a former Neilburg Composite School grade 12 graduate that has decided to pursue a post-secondary program of 1 year or longer after being out of high school for a year. A paragraph informing the principal of the program the individual is enrolling in, the length of the course, location of school are required. This needs to be to the NCS Principal by June 1 deadline. This award is given at the NCS awards day.

## 7. Neilburg Legion Branch #135 Scholarship & Bursary

June 1

<u>\$500 The Scholarship</u> is based on academic standing and submission of Remembrance Day essay, poster, poem or participation in other Legion activities in Grade 12 year. Must be pursuing a post-secondary education.

\$500 The Bursary is based on financial need and ties to the Legion or military service, submission of Remembrance Day essay, poster, poem or participation in other Legion activities in Grade 12 year. Must be pursuing a post-secondary education.
