

CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION

Background

The Division recognizes the need to instruct students in Canadian citizenship and to participate in patriotic observances and exercises. The teaching of this core value presents itself within and without the curriculum.

Procedures

In addition to the formal instruction schools shall make provisions for:

- 1. Displaying a photograph of the current monarch (this may include photographs of the Governor-General and the Lieutenant Governor).
- 2. Displaying and usage of proper protocol of the Canadian and Saskatchewan flags, both inside and outside the school.
- 3. Displaying of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms.
- 4. Singing of "O Canada" at patriotic and special events.
- 5. Observing such nationally recognized days as Remembrance Day.
