

DRIVER EDUCATION

Background

The Division provides a Driver Education program which is consistent with the Education Act, the Education Regulations and the course of study approved by the Ministry of Education.

Procedures

- 1. The Division will contract for the provision of Driver Education.
- 2. The Driver Education course of study is to consist of:
 - 2.1 Thirty (30) or more hours of classroom instruction.
 - 2.2 Six (6) or more hours of in-car.

These are to be offered concurrently wherever possible.

- 3. The Regulations govern the actual course, record keeping, official recording and the qualifications of the instructor.
- 4. Supervision and evaluation of the program is the responsibility of the Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction. The Superintendent shall consult with the Principal and the instructor(s) to ensure scheduling and enforcement of all requirements of the program.
- 5. Driver Education for all students who qualify at the school level will be provided. All students aged fifteen (15) by agreed upon cutoff date and attending a junior or senior school are eligible for this program.
- 6. The Driver Education program shall also be offered to home-based education students in the Division.
