

## GUIDANCE AND CAREER COUNSELING PROGRAM

## Background

The Division directs that guidance and career counseling services be provided to students to enable them to plan, select and pursue studies for their educational, personal and vocational advancement.

## Procedures

- 1. All schools are required to adopt and implement a career education life skills program following provincial curriculum guidelines.
- 2. In kindergarten through grade eight career education life skills are to be integrated with the regular subjects of the curriculum as much as possible.
- 3. Secondary schools are required to implement career counseling services for students, providing them with specific information regarding career clinics, tests related to career choices and information pertaining to post-secondary institutions.
- 4. Direction regarding the provision of personal counseling services is contained within the Student Services Handbook.
- myBlueprint is a mandatory program from grades 9-12. The provision of a graduation plan and appropriate supplemental documents is required for all students in grades 9-12.
