

INTERNS AND FIELD EXPERIENCE

Background

The Division accepts the practice of internship and field experience as determined by recognized post-secondary institutions. The Division and the professional staff support interns as they continue their training to become recognized and certified.

Procedures

- 1. Principals may approve and shall submit a list of teachers requesting student teachers and interns to the Superintendent of Human Resources. The Superintendent of Human Resources will coordinate student placements with the post-secondary institution.
- 2. The teacher and Principal will be responsible for supervising the student teacher or intern in the approved activities which the student teacher or intern undertakes as a part of his/her student teaching or internship experience. Such activities shall normally be assigned by the responsible teacher or Principal and shall be recognized as part of the approved instructional and/or co-curricular activities in the school system.
- 3. Teachers who provide the professional supervision services will be given the necessary days to attend required professional workshops with the intern teacher.
- 4. Interns will be allotted a specific monthly allowance as provided by the current rate list.
- 5. Interns will be required to sign a Commitment of Confidentiality.
