

PURCHASE OF SERVICES

Background

The Division contracts for educational services for students when it is not feasible or practical to provide the services within the Division.

Procedures

- 1. The Director may purchase services from other institutions and Divisions when the Division is unable to provide a specific program or service for a student with special needs. Such service or program is to be consistent with those provided in accordance with Ministry of Education regulations and policies.
- 2. The Director may purchase service from another Division when lack of classroom space or geographical location necessitates transportation to another Division.
- 3. All services purchased in accordance with this administrative procedure are to be reported to the Chief Financial Officer, who is responsible for payment of the service.
