In Progress Items:

School Roof Approval: Looks like they will be ready to start October 23, 2017. Contractors have been here to look at it.

Nut Aware Initiative: Lynda has done presentation on anaphylactic shock and what it looks like. Students know where the nut free table is and how to use it. Parents should be made aware to be sure to tell their child when they have food containing nuts in their lunches.

Disaster Plaster Fundraiser: We raised \$1080 in this fundraiser.

Co-op Gift Card: Stacey will look into getting us ready to start this fundraiser. We will sell from November 1 -14, 2017

AED Machines and First Aid: The Rec Centre has applied for a grant from Sasklotteries to help with or cover the costs. The defibrillator will be placed in the hall/gym. It will be fully automated and there will be a First Aid kit included. There will be instructions on how to use it on a child and also how to use it on an adult.

There are no set standards or requirements right now on teachers or staff with First Aid in the school. The Green Acre SCC would like the Division to consider adding First Aid to the curriculum. Maybe there could be a PD day to obtain their certificate, and there could be a ratio for students to teachers with First Aid. Terry Craig will look into it.

Cindy Ernewien Update: The care package the SCC purchased has been given to her. Bobbi will submit her receipts. (Rapid View Community raised \$15,000 to help Cindy's family be with her).
