Principal and Vice-Principal's Message

In December our Grade 4 Students completed the OurSCHOOL Survey. Below are a few of the outcomes along with a couple comments stating how the students rated our school:

- In our school, 88% of the girls and 91% of the boys have a high sense of belonging. The Canadian norm for girls is 83% and for boys is 82%.
- 100% of the girls and 100% of the boys in our school are interested and • motivated. The Canadian norm for girls is 91% and for boys is 86%.
- 98% of students in our school value school outcomes: the Canadian norm for these • grades is 96%.
- 35% of students in our school have moderate to high levels of anxiety; the • Canadian norm for these grades is 22%.
- 88% of the girls and 70% of the boys feel safe attending our school. The ٠ Canadian norm for girls is 68% and for boys is 64%
- In our school, positive teacher-student relations were rated 8.9 out of 10; the • Canadian norm for these grades is 8.6.
- In our school, students rated teachers' expectations for academic success 9.1 •
 - out of 10; the Canadian norm for these grades is 8.7.
- 93% of our students answered "YES" to the following question: "Do you feel connected to an adult in your building and would go to them if you need support?"

"I really like all of the teachers in our school. I think we could change the number of people allowed in the bathrooms at one time."




SECOND STEP
