## The Importance of School Attendance

### BARKLEY SAYS:

**A**lways do your best

**R**espect Others

**Y**es to life-long learning

**Research has proven that there is a high correlation between school attendance and academic performance and success, while absence from school is often the greatest single cause of poor performance and achievement.**

### **Why is it so IMPORTANT to attend every day?**

- Learning is a progressive activity; each day's lessons build upon those of the previous day(s).
- Reading the material and completing work independently does not compensate for the loss of insight gained during class time.
- Regular student participation in daily classroom activities plays a significant role in a student's school success.

### **Are there other benefits?**

- Students with good attendance records generally achieve higher grades and enjoy school more.
- Having a good education will help to give your child the best possible start in life.
- Regular school attendance patterns encourage the development of other responsible patterns of behavior.
- Students who develop an "on the job" attitude toward school will be more desirable to future employers.



### **What are the risks of frequent absences?**

- A child who does not attend school regularly will be unlikely to keep up with the work.
- The more the students miss school, the lower their grades; the lower the grades, the less likely they want to stay in school; the less they want to stay in school, the more likely they will drop out of school.

### **What can Parents do to HELP?**

- Parents must model the value of education, including the importance of regular attendance.
- Make sure your child goes to school regularly and arrives on time - you will establish a good habit that will carry through life.
- If your child is ill or must miss school for some other reason, contact the school immediately. If you ask for homework, make sure your child completes it.
- Whenever possible, arrange family vacations during school holidays so that children miss as little school as possible.
- Take an interest in your child's school work and be involved in the school as much as possible - your child will value school more if you do.

To help ensure a safe environment for our students, the NWSD busses may have video surveillance systems installed. This includes both audio and video monitoring.
