Saskatchewan Graduation Requirements:

Grade 10	At least 8 credits including: • ELA A10 and ELA B10 • Social Studies 10, History 10 or Native Studies 10 • Science 10 • Foundations Math 10 or Workplace Math 10 • 3 electives at 10, 20 or 30 level • Students require Wellness 10, PE 20 or PE 30 to graduate. Students at NCS typically fulfill this requirement in Grade 10.
Grade 11	At least 16 credits including: • English Language Arts 20 • Pre-calculus 20, Foundations Math 20 or Workplace Math 20 • 6 electives at 20 or 30 level • Students require a social science credit (such as Social Studies 20 or History 20) to graduate. Students at NCS typically fulfill this requirement in Grade 11.
Grade 12	At least 24 credits (at least 5 at the 30 level) including: • ELA A30 and ELA B30 • Social Studies 30, History 30 or Native Studies 30 • an additional social science at the 20 or 30 level (usually achieved in Grade 11) • a science at the 20 or 30 level (usually achieved in Grade 11) • two credits in arts education or practical and applied arts at the 10, 20, or 30 level • Wellness 10, PE 20 or PE 30 (usually achieved in Grade 10)
